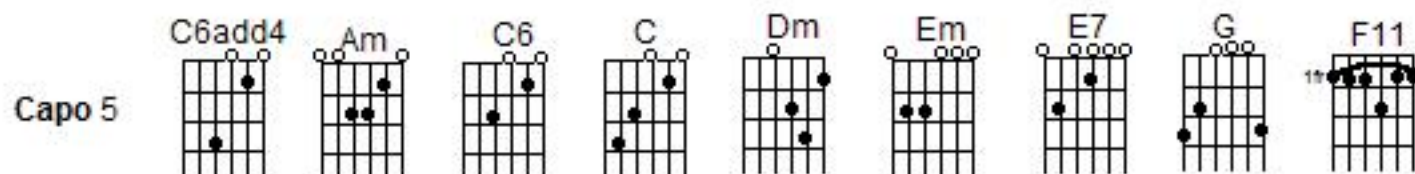


WHAT A WONDERFUL WORLD
